

Minutes of Campus Safety Committee Meeting of April 19, 2012

Location: Lee Hall

Lost Time Injuries: No new lost time injuries have been reported.

Interior Glazing: M. Kinsella reported that the glazing study is nearly complete. The architect is returning to campus for one last field verification.

DOL Visit: One remaining violation to be corrected, the Theater wood storage racks in the scene shop. The new system has been ordered.

Site Lighting: N. Payne reported on light surveys taken near the track, the Health Center and at the “lower Bugbee” area. Light levels have improved at the track and Health Center locations. The lower Bugbee area is being upgraded this summer.

Lee Hall Abatement: H. Delancy reported that abatement issues in Lee Hall due to the water intrusion have all been properly addressed by SUCF in consultation with the project environmental engineer.

Fire Inspection: A few violations remain. The committee discussed some of them. A meeting of key personnel will be convened to develop solutions. N. Payne reported that Lee Hall fire watches have been trained to address the EXIT issues identified by the inspector.

Milne Library: S. Barton reported that Room 309 will not be used for an office for the Fizzle surge. It is currently a work zone.

Mac Duff Drill: The committee discussed the “live” full-scale drill at MacDuff Hall. While there were several lessons learned, it went well.

PPE: R. Roberts briefed the committee on significant progress in Personal Protective Equipment in the shops. Additional equipment for the electricians has been ordered. Each electrician needs to be measured for their kit items.

Tool Box Safety Talks: R. Roberts reported that MOC supervisors are conducting monthly “tool box safety talks”.

Site Safety: The committee reviewed the issues regarding pedestrian/residence/mowing site safety in the Curtis Hall area and discussed an upcoming project.


Morris Roof: J. Young reported possible snow slide issues at the rear ADA entrance to Morris. S. Barton will follow up.
